The BORR contract was awarded to Southwest Connex, now known as the South West Gateway Alliance or 'The Alliance'.

The Alliance model comprises a group of firms specialising in civil design and construction. It is managed by a Board which includes representation from Main Roads WA.

Our task locally is to work with and understand The Alliance and to help them deliver \$300 million in local goods and services over the next three years.

Over the coming weeks we'll be gathering information about what work is upcoming, helping to connect local contractors with opportunity and working to ensure any
